

**MEL BROWN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP
&
BOB SPENCE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP
FOR POST SECONDARY STUDIES
TERMS OF REFERENCE**

General

The Northwest Territories and Nunavut Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists (NAPEG) Education Foundation may award two scholarships in each academic year to an amount of two-thousand dollars (\$2000.00) to a successful applicant.

Objectives

The objectives of the scholarships are to:

- 1) identify and encourage the fields of Engineering and Geoscience to the Northwest Territories and Nunavut residents as established and respected careers;
- 2) recognize and financially assist the Northwest Territories and Nunavut students enrolled in a recognized program leading to a university degree in engineering or geoscience; and
- 3) increase public awareness of NAPEG as an organization actively concerned about encouraging all young people in the engineering and geoscience professions, present and future community leadership through its membership, and the continued growth of the professions in the Northwest Territories and Nunavut.

Eligibility

Applicant will be a Northwest Territories or a Nunavut student entering or attending post secondary studies leading to a degree in Engineering or Geoscience at an undergraduate level in a recognized university. A NWT/NU student is defined as a person whose principal residence has been located within the Northwest Territories or Nunavut for a minimum period of twelve (12) months immediately preceding the award of any scholarship, bursary, grant or financial assistance. Should an individual have been a student at a school outside of the Northwest Territories or Nunavut during the immediately preceding twelve (12) month period; the individual will be deemed to have maintained his or her principal residence in the Northwest Territories or Nunavut for that period, so long as he or she has maintained a valid Northwest Territories or Nunavut Health Care Card for that period as well.

Preference will be given to highly motivated individuals with a strong academic background and demonstrated citizenship and leadership capabilities.

Application

The applicant must complete the attached Scholarship Application Form.

The applicant will be evaluated in a systematic manner based on each of the items enumerated in the application form.

Application Closing Date

The scholarships will be advertised for eligible candidates commencing May of each year.

Applications must be received by the NAPEG Executive Director by the **30th of September**.

Final decision for awarding the scholarship will be made by the NAPEG Council in December of the same year.

The NAPEG Council has the right to decide the number and amount of scholarships awarded each year.
