



## **MEMBER-in-TRAINING AWARD TERMS of REFERENCE**

### **Purpose**

The Member-in-Training Award recognizes achievement by a Member-in-Training. The award is intended to bestow distinction on those training to be engineers or geoscientists who enhance society's knowledge of our professions.

### **Eligibility Criteria**

The award recipient will meet the following criteria:

- the recipient must reside in the Northwest Territories or Nunavut; and
- the recipient must be registered with NAPEG (recipients who have received their professional designations within the last calendar year are eligible for this award).

NAPEG reserves the right to cancel, withdraw or amend any award without prior notice.

### **Nomination Procedure**

- In December each year, NAPEG will forward the call for nominations to NAPEG membership, as well as other potentially interested parties.
- The deadline for submitting nominations is 4:00 pm on January 31<sup>st</sup> each year.
- All nominations must be submitted to the Honours & Awards Committee of NAPEG.
- Self-nominations are encouraged.
- Guidelines on completing and submitting a nomination are included with the nominations form.

### **Selection Criteria**

Consideration will be given to continued leadership in the profession and in the community, to outstanding achievements, and to recognition obtained. Nominees will be rated as follows:

#### **Work-related achievements (20 points)**

- Engineering and geoscience excellence, and recognition of achievements within the profession, business or industry, or education sector.



### **Service to the profession (60 points)**

- Public education and understanding of the role of engineering and geoscience.
- Serving an active role and providing an active voice for MIT ideas and issues within NAPEG.
- Active participation in engineering and/or geoscience societies, institutes, etc.

### **Service to the community (20 points)**

- Active participation in commissions, voluntary organizations, community organizations, and other paid and/or unpaid work beyond the profession.

### **Selection Process**

Recipients will be selected by the Honours & Awards Committee of NAPEG, and formally approved by the NAPEG Council.

### **Announcements**

- The recipients will be notified in writing.
- The award will be presented during the annual NAPEG Awards Dinner in May of the respective awards year.
- The award recipients agree to standard publicity notification arranged by NAPEG.
