SCIENCE TEACHING AWARD TERMS of REFERENCE

Purpose

The Science Teaching Award is to recognize teaching initiatives which promote an interest in careers in the sciences.

Eligibility Criteria

The award recipient will meet the following criteria:

- The recipient must be a certified teacher practicing in the Northwest Territories or Nunavut.

Multiple awards may be presented each year, subject to the availability of worthy nominations. NAPEG reserves the right to cancel, withdraw or amend any award without prior notice.

Nomination Procedure

- In January/February each year, NAPEG will forward the call for nominations to NAPEG membership, as well as to NT and NU Schools.
- The deadline for submitting nominations is 4:00 pm on January 31st year.
- Self-nominations are encouraged.
- All nominations must be submitted to the Honours & Awards Committee of NAPEG.
- Guidelines on completing and submitting a nomination are included with the nominations form.

Selection Criteria

Consideration will be given to the practice of teaching excellence that develops and promotes an interest in the fields of science to their students. The Honours and Awards Committee is particularly interested in information and comments from fellow teaching staff and students on how the nominated teacher has accomplished this goal.

Selection Process

Recipients will be selected by the Honours & Awards Committee of NAPEG, and formally approved by the NAPEG Council.
